The American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED program helps participants recognize and respond appropriately to cardiac, breathing and first aid emergencies. The courses in this program teach the knowledge and skills needed to give immediate care to an injured or ill person (adult, child or infant) and to decide whether advanced medical care is needed. Certification is valid for two years from the certification date. When you sign up for the class, you must pay right away. There will be no refunds if you did not notify the instructor within 24 hours of the class. There will be a half-hour break for lunch.
